Staying in Touch with Our Neighborhood

The meeting of Central Neighborhood Association was held on 17 April, 2003 at the Central Grade School. We had a great turn out of 30 people. Not bad! We heard from our Guest Speaker Mr. Keith DeYoung, Deputy Director of the Grand Traverse Central Dispatch, about the health of the 911 system and the outdated Motorola Radio systems. What they are recommending is that Grand Traverse Board of Commissioners be authorized to assess for a period of (5) years and additional monthly surcharge by telephone service supplier for a 1-party access line with the Grand Traverse. This surcharge would not exceed \$3.20 a month. This of course will be up for a vote soon!

Tim Luckey spoke of using two Web Pages, <http://wearetraversecity.com> and <http://www.historictraverse.com>. Both of these web hosts have offered us sections on their web pages for Central Neighborhood. Tim recommends we use both combined with our e-mail data base. This will greatly assist us in keeping our neighbors informed.

Tim also spoke briefly about our Non-profit Corporation status and By-laws. Both were passed around the room for comment. We will be resubmitting them to the Michigan Department of Consumer & Industrial Services to regain our status.

Tim Spoke about the Election of Officers and Directors and how it ties to our Non-profit Corporation Status. We have to fill the officer positions and have a board of directors.

Adrienne Rossi Spoke about Zoning and Traffic Committee's or Working Groups to address the issues of traffic in the Neighborhood. If you are interested in the this subject or have a concern please contact Adrienne or Tim Luckey

Tim & Adrienne spoke about the possible changes to the intersection of Front & Wadsworth and Eighth and Locust Streets. These changes were put before the City Traffic Committee and as of now are just in the early stages of discussion.

Stewie Zacks gave us an update on the Power Pole on Wadsworth Street and Shirley Forton gave us an update on Bata.
